Subject: Urgent Attention Required: Unusual Spike in Voter Addition and Deletion Applications

Dear Sir,

I am writing to bring to your immediate attention a significant rise in the number of voter addition and deletion applications received in the New Delhi Assembly Constituency over the past few days. For your ready reference, a snapshot of these applications is enclosed below:

It is concerning that these applications have been submitted after the conclusion of the comprehensive Special Summary Revision exercise. This raises serious concerns about a sinister plan to tinker with the electoral rolls, which are the very foundation of any free and fair election.

To address this matter, I kindly request you to provide details of individuals (objectors) who have submitted more than five deletion applications since October 29, 2024. Specifically, we seek either their EPIC details or copies of Form 7 filed by them. I have enclosed the list of such individuals who have filed more than 5 forms from 29 October to 25 December 2024. **Who are these individuals who are so keen to get names of voters deleted at such a large scale? At whose behest are operating? What are their intentions?**

To safeguard the integrity of the electoral process, I strongly urge that no further voter deletions be carried out in the constituency unless it is a case of Migration (i.e. Form 8) and a death case which must be duly accompanied with a death certificate. In any case, no deletion should be undertaken without rigorous verification. If the Election



Commission deems it absolutely necessary to delete any voter's name, such actions must be preceded by thorough on-ground verification conducted by the Booth Level Officer (BLO) in the presence of Booth Level Agents (BLA-1 and BLA-2) of all parties. This step is essential to ensure that no genuine voter is unfairly removed.

Furthermore, I would like to remind you of the following critical responsibilities of the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) which are notified in the Rules:

1. Deletions

- a. Conduct personal cross-verification of deletions applications in polling stations where deletions applications exceed 2% of the total electors in the voters' list.
- b. Personally verify deletions applications where the same individual (objector) has raised objections in more than five cases.

Kindly refer to **para 11.4.5 of Manual on Electoral Rolls 2023**, issued by the Election Commission of India.

Note: The total voters in the New Delhi Assembly Constituency as per Draft Electoral Roll issued on 29 October 2024 are **1,06,873** and total deletion applications received from 29 October to 25 December are **5,692**, which is **5.33%** of the total voters and thus no deletion can be done without the personal cross verification by the ERO.

Note: As mentioned above, kindly refer to the enclosed list of objectors who have filed more than 5 applications. A total of **81 individuals have filed 4529** applications and thus no deletion can be done without the personal cross verification by the ERO in these cases as well.

2. Additions



- a. Ensure the Assistant Electoral Registration Officer (AERO) conducts field verification in polling stations where proposed additions exceed 4% of the previous total electors.
- b. Personally verify 10% of the forms processed by the AERO.

Kindly refer to **para 11.4.3 & 11.4.4 of Manual on Electoral Rolls 2023**, issued by the Election Commission of India.

Note: As mentioned above the total voters in the New Delhi Assembly Constituency are **1,06,873** and total addition applications received from 29 October to 25 December are **7,876**, which is **7.37%** of the total voters and thus no addition can be done without the personal field visit by the AERO and personal 10% cross verification by the ERO.

The ground-verification schedule of ERO must be shared with BLAs of all political parties in advance, so that representatives of political parties can accompany the said ERO during the process.

Lastly, please note that your office is required to flag any critical influx of Forms 6, 7, or 8 in any assembly constituency to the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) [Kindly refer to **para 11.4.7.(iv) of Manual on Electoral Rolls 2023**]. I urge you to escalate this matter to the CEO at the earliest.
