Event: Report of a threat to high-end hotels

The U.S. Consulate General Karachi received a report of a threat directed at high-end hotels in Karachi. In response to such threats, the U.S. Embassy and Consulates sometimes place areas such as tourist attractions, hotels, markets, shopping malls and restaurants off-limits to official U.S. government personnel.

The U.S. Consulate General in Karachi has temporarily limited visits by official U.S. government personnel to these hotels.

Actions to take:

- Avoid the areas.
- Avoid crowds.
- Keep a low profile.
- Be aware of your surroundings.
- Stay alert in locations frequented by tourists/Westerners.
